SCRATCHINGS

Should you have to scratch from the event, please SMS your details to 0437 527 376.

CANTEEN – Open for breakfast and will run all day! The much loved Café 2U van will also be available on the day for all your “real” coffee needs!

CAMPING – power, hot showers and metal horse yards are available. Cost is \$15 per vehicle per night and is payable with entry. BRC will pass on camping fees to the Bungendore Showground Trust.

DAY YARDS – A large number are available FREE, no need to book. Please leave clean at end of the day.

Rules

This event is being conducted in accordance with the current 2011 EA Dressage Rules and in conjunction with the EA General Regulations and by-laws unless stated otherwise (available under “EA Rules and Regs” at www.equestrian.org.au or click on text for link to site). **Please be aware that it is the competitor’s responsibility to ensure they have read and understood the rules prior to riding at the event and submission of an entry is deemed acceptance of these rules.**

Entries

- **Entries close 6pm sharp on Saturday, 11 February 2012. Entries and accompanying payment must be received by this date** (payment may be made online by credit card or EFT, or by cheque made out to BRC Inc, and mailed to BRC, PO Box 512, Bungendore, NSW 2621).
- Horses are limited to three consecutive classes but riders may enter more than one horse. Each horse is limited to one rider.
- Numbers are limited. Entries will be accepted on a first in basis.
- No refund of entries after closing date unless a valid veterinary or medical certificate is supplied within 48 hours of the event.
- Late entries may be accepted if numbers allow and will incur a **\$30 late fee**.
- **The Draw, Day Program and Map of ground layout will be posted on the BRC website homepage, www.brc.org.au on Wednesday evening, 15 February 2012.** Please note that the Organising Committee may choose to amend the draw after this date, as necessary. Riders affected by any changes will be notified by email or phone.

On the Day...

- Enquiries Desk will be open all day, located in the canteen area.
- All riders are required to present to the **Gear check steward** prior to riding your test; location will be indicated on the ground map to be advised once the Draw is complete.
- All riders must wear an EA approved helmet whenever mounted at the venue. Acceptable standards are: AS/NZS 3838 (Current Australian Standard), or EN 1384 (Current European Standard), or ASTN F1163 (Current US Standard). Failure to wear an approved helmet shall be penalised by elimination at the discretion of the committee.
- Attire - Formal. Reasonable judgement will be used on the day regarding the weather and the need to wear a hacking jacket. Jackets and plaiting are optional for Classes 1 & 2.
- In the event inclement weather or if you are unsure of anything, please call the Event Coordinator.
- Tests will be available 30 minutes after the final results have been posted.

CODE OF CONDUCT and SAFETY

BRC’s Code of Conduct applies to the activity day, and is available to be read at the enquiries desk. Please ensure you are familiar with it. **NO DOGS** are allowed on the main arena and must be on a leash within any other part of the showground. Please ensure that your gear/equipment/horse/pony is in good safe working order. If you are riding, you will be required to wear an approved riding helmet (ASNZS 3838) or other approved by the EA and appropriate clothing and footwear as set out in the Club’s Code of Conduct. You are also asked to disclose any medical conditions or allergies in order for BRC to provide the best assistance in the event of an incident. BRC is an EA affiliated club and, as such, is covered by Public Liability Insurance.
